Rules and Regulations

GENERAL RULES

- All teams have to strictly adhere to the following rules and regulations.
- 8-member squad (7-a-side game).
- No player can play for more than one team.
- The teams must report to the registration desk at least 30 minutes before the start of the match.
- Umpire decisions will be final. No arguments whatsoever will be entertained. Teams disrespecting their decision may be disqualified from the Tournament.
- Interpretation of these Rules & Conditions, their construction and effect rests entirely with Sports Committee. All decisions taken by this Sports Committee will be final and binding on all the participants.
- The match shall be played strictly on the dates and Time fixed failing to play the match will be treated as walkover.
- **Each match will have 5 overs while the semi finals – However organizers reserve the right to reduce overs in case there is a constraint on time**
- Each team will be given maximum 20 minutes to complete their overs.
- Bowling will be from one side only to facilitate quick change of overs
- No bowler will be allowed to bowl more than 2 overs.
- No under-arm bowling will be allowed.

- Umpires will explain allotted time for each match before the start – innings have to be completed within the time.
- **For overs no.1-4, wide balls and no balls will be counted as deliveries but invite a 3 run penalty. For the last over i.e. 5th over, wide balls and no balls will have to be re-bowled with the regular 1 run penalty.**
- Every player should wear sports shoes / cricket spikes are not allowed
- Teams which win Round 1 on 10th December 2016 will be required to play R2 till Finals on Day 2 i.e. 11th December 2016.
- The tournament is a straight draw of 24 teams >
 - Round 1 – R24 – 12 teams to go thru to R2
 - Round 2 – R12 – 6 teams to go thru to R3
 - Round 3 – R6 – 3 team to go thru to R4
 - Round 4 – of the 3 teams, a lucky winner will go to the FINAL direct while the other 2 will play off for the other Final Spot
 - Round 5 - FINAL

Other Rules:

1. Each team shall mandatorily comply with the reporting timings given accordingly in the fixture.
2. Following penalty will be applicable for the team not reporting on time;
 - a. Maximum 5 minutes' grace time given from the scheduled starting time of the match
 - b. If team reports after 5 minutes of given grace time, team will be disqualified and opponent team will get a walkover
3. There will be no official break for drinks in innings and matches would be played continuously.
4. LBW rules will not apply – all other methods of wickets will apply to batting side.
